For I know whom I have believed, and am persuaded that he is able to keep that which I have committed unto him against that day. 2 Tim: 1:12

I have eternal life.

For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. 17: For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved. 18: He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God. 19: And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil. 20: For every one that doeth evil hateth the light, neither cometh to the light, lest his deeds should be reprov'd. 21: But he that doeth truth cometh to the light, that his deeds may be made manifest, that they are wrought in God. Jn: 3:16-21

Ye shall know them by their fruits. Do men gather grapes of thorns, or figs of thistles? 17: Even so every good tree bringeth forth good fruit; but a corrupt tree bringeth forth evil fruit. 18: A good tree cannot bring forth evil fruit, neither can a corrupt tree bring forth good fruit. 19: **Every tree that bringeth not forth good fruit is hewn down, and cast into the fire.** 20: **Wherefore by their fruits ye shall know them.** 21: **Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.** Matt: 7:16-21

Go ye therefore into the highways, and as many as ye shall find, bid to the marriage. 10: So those servants went out into the highways, and gathered together all as many as they found, both bad and good: and the wedding was furnished with guests. 11: And when the king came in to see the guests, he saw there a man which had not on a wedding garment: **12: And he saith unto him, Friend, how camest thou in hither not having a wedding garment? And he was speechless.** **13: Then said the king to the servants, Bind him hand and foot, and take him away, and cast him into outer darkness; there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.** 14: For many are called, but few are chosen. Matt: 22:1-14

I am the true vine, and my Father is the husbandman. 2: **Every branch in me that beareth not fruit he taketh away:** and every branch that beareth fruit, he purgeth it, that it may bring forth more fruit. Jn: 15:1-2

I call heaven and earth to record this day against you, that **I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing:** therefore choose life, that both thou and thy seed may live: 20: **That thou mayest love the LORD thy God, and that thou mayest obey his voice, and that thou mayest cleave unto him: for he is thy life, and the length of thy days:** that thou mayest dwell in the land which the LORD swore unto thy fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, to give them. Deut: 30:19-20

Ye that fear the LORD, trust in the LORD: he is their help and their shield. The LORD hath been mindful of us: he will bless us; he will bless the house of Israel; he will bless the house of Aaron. **He will bless them that fear the LORD, both small and great.** Ps: 115:11-13

Blessed is every one that feareth the LORD; that walketh in his ways. For thou shalt eat the labour of thine hands: happy shalt thou be, and it shall be well with thee. Ps: 128:1-2

Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the LORD of hosts, if **I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it. 11: And I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes, and he shall not destroy the fruits of your ground; neither shall your vine cast her fruit before the time in the field, saith the LORD of hosts.12: And all nations shall call you blessed: for ye shall be a delightsome land, saith the LORD of hosts.** Mal: 3:10-12

God guides me, leads me, and teaches me.

The meek will he guide in judgment: and the meek will he teach his way. Ps: 25:9

What man is he that feareth the LORD? **him shall he teach in the way that he shall choose. His soul shall dwell at ease; and his seed shall inherit the earth. The secret of the LORD is with them that fear him; and he will shew them his covenant.** Ps: 25:12-14

. . . **He leadeth me beside the still waters. 3: He restoreth my soul: he leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake.** Ps: 23: 2-3

I delight myself in the Lord and he gives me my heart's desire.

Delight thyself also in the LORD; and he shall give thee the desires of thine heart. Ps: 37:4

I shall not want or lack any good thing.

The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want. Ps: 23:1

The young lions do lack, and suffer hunger: but **they that seek the LORD shall not want any good thing.** Psalms 34:10

For the LORD God is a sun and shield: the LORD will give grace and glory: **no good thing will he withhold from them that walk uprightly.** Ps: 84:11

Therefore take no thought, saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, Wherewithal shall we be clothed? (For after all these things do the Gentiles seek:) for your heavenly Father knoweth that ye have need of all these things. **But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.** Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself. Sufficient unto the day is the evil thereof. Matt: 6:31-34

God gives me beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, and the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness.

To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that he might be glorified. Isa: 61:3

I am like a tree planted by the rivers of water, I bring forth fruit in the season; my leaf shall not wither; and whatsoever I do shall prosper.

Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful. But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night. And **he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.** Ps: 1:1-3

The righteous shall flourish like the palm tree: he shall grow like a cedar in Lebanon. 13: Those that be planted in the house of the LORD shall flourish in the courts of our God. 14: **They shall still bring forth fruit in old age; they shall be fat and flourishing;** 15: To shew that the LORD is upright: he is my rock, and there is no unrighteousness in him. Psalms. 92:12-15

All things are possible with God and all things can be to him that believes.

But Jesus beheld them, and said unto them, **With men this is impossible; but with God all things are possible.** Matt: 19:26

Jesus said unto him, **If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth.**

Mk :9:23

And the LORD said unto Moses, **Is the LORD's hand waxed short?** thou shalt see now whether my word shall come to pass unto thee or not. Num:11:23

I commit my way unto the Lord and He brings it to pass for me.

Commit thy way unto the LORD; trust also in him; and he shall bring it to pass. Ps: 37:5

God makes me the head and not the tail.

And the LORD shall make thee the head, and not the tail; and thou shalt be above only, and thou shalt not be beneath; if that thou hearken unto the commandments of the LORD thy God, which I command thee this day, to observe and to do them: Deut: 28:13

And the LORD hath avouched thee this day to be his peculiar people, as he hath promised thee, and that thou shouldest keep all his commandments; And **to make thee high above all nations which he hath made, in praise, and in name, and in honour;** and that thou mayest be an holy people unto the LORD thy God, as he hath spoken. Deut: 26:18

I deal wisely and have good success.

This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success. Jos: 1:8

God hears me when I call to Him.

But know that the LORD hath set apart him that is godly for himself: **the LORD will hear when I call unto him.** Ps: 4:3

The eyes of the LORD are upon the righteous, and **his ears are open unto their cry.** Ps: 34:15

And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us: And if we know that he hear us, whatsoever we ask, **we know that we have the petitions that we desired of him.** 1Jn: 5:14-15

For the eyes of the LORD run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to shew himself strong in the behalf of them whose heart is perfect toward him. 2Chron: 16:9

But as for us, the LORD is our God, and we have not forsaken him; and the priests, which minister unto the LORD, are the sons of Aaron, and the Levites wait upon their business: 11: And they burn unto the LORD every morning and every evening burnt sacrifices and sweet incense: the shewbread also set they in order upon the pure table; and the candlestick of gold with the lamps thereof, to burn every evening: for we keep the charge of the LORD our God; but ye have forsaken him.12: And, **behold, God himself is with us for our captain,** and his priests with sounding trumpets to cry alarm against you. O children of Israel, fight ye not against the LORD God of your fathers; for ye shall not prosper. 2Chron: 13:10

The LORD is my keeper: the LORD is my shade upon my right hand.

I will lift up mine eyes unto the hills, from whence cometh my help. 2: My help cometh from the LORD, which made heaven and earth. 3: He will not suffer thy foot to be moved: he that keepeth thee will not slumber. 4: Behold, he that keepeth Israel shall neither slumber nor sleep. 5: **The**

LORD is thy keeper: the LORD is thy shade upon thy right hand. 6: The sun shall not smite thee by day, nor the moon by night. 7: **The LORD shall preserve thee from all evil:** he shall preserve thy soul. 8: The LORD shall preserve thy going out and thy coming in from this time forth, and even for evermore. Ps: 121:1-8

The Lord delivers me out of all my afflictions and troubles.

Many are the afflictions of the righteous: but the LORD delivereth him out of them all.
Ps: 34:19

And call upon me in the day of trouble: I will deliver thee, and thou shalt glorify me.
Ps: 50:15

Because he hath set his love upon me, therefore will **I deliver him: I will set him on high,** because he hath known my name. He shall call upon me, and **I will answer him: I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honour him.** Ps: 91:14-15

Ye that love the LORD, hate evil: **he preserveth the souls of his saints; he delivereth them out of the hand of the wicked.** Ps: 97:10

The name of the LORD is a strong tower: the righteous runneth into it, and is safe.
Prov: 18:10

Say not thou, I will recompense evil; **but wait on the LORD, and he shall save thee.**
Prov: 20:22

But now thus saith the LORD that created thee, O Jacob, and he that formed thee, O Israel, Fear not: for I have redeemed thee, I have called thee by thy name; thou art mine. **When thou passest through the waters, I will be with thee; and through the rivers, they shall not overflow thee: when thou walkest through the fire, thou shalt not be burned; neither shall the flame kindle upon thee.** Isa: 43:1-2

The angel of the LORD encamps round about me and delivers me.

The angel of the LORD encampeth round about them that fear him, **and delivereth them.**
Ps: 34:7

The LORD is my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer; my God, my strength, in whom I will trust; my buckler, and the horn of my salvation, and my high tower. Ps: 18:2

Blessed is the man whom thou chastenest, O LORD, and teachest him out of thy law; 13: That thou mayest give him rest from the days of adversity, until the pit be digged for the wicked. 14: For the LORD will not cast off his people, neither will he forsake his inheritance. 15: But judgment shall return unto righteousness: and all the upright in heart shall follow it. 16: Who will rise up for me against the evildoers? or who will stand up for me against the workers of iniquity? 17: **Unless the LORD had been my help, my soul had almost dwelt in silence.** 18: **When I said, My foot slippeth; thy mercy, O LORD, held me up.** 19: In the multitude of my thoughts within me thy comforts delight my soul. 20: Shall the throne of iniquity have fellowship with thee, which frameth mischief by a law? 21: They gather themselves together against the soul of the righteous, and condemn the innocent blood. 22: **But the LORD is my defence; and my God is the rock of my refuge.** 23: And he shall bring upon them their own iniquity, and shall cut

them off in their own wickedness; yea, the LORD our God shall cut them off.
Ps: 94:12-23

God will tread down my enemies.

Through God we shall do valiantly: **for he it is that shall tread down our enemies.** Ps: 60:12

I will lift up mine eyes unto the hills, from whence cometh my help. **My help cometh from the LORD**, which made heaven and earth. Many sorrows shall be to the wicked: but he that trusteth in the LORD, mercy shall compass him about. Psalms 32:10

Cast thy burden upon the LORD, and he shall sustain thee: he shall never suffer the righteous to be moved. Ps: 55:22

God's hand is upon me for good.

...The hand of our God is upon all them for good that seek him; Ezra: 8:22

God keeps me in perfect peace because I trust in him.

Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee. Isa: 26:3

For thus saith the Lord GOD, the Holy One of Israel; **In returning and rest shall ye be saved; in quietness and in confidence shall be your strength: and ye would not.** Isa: 30:15

Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid. Jn: 14:21

Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. And **the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.** Phil: 4:6-7

God gives me grace to meet every situation.

And God is able to make all grace abound toward you; that ye, always having all sufficiency in all things, may abound to every good work: 2Cor: 9:8:

But he giveth more grace. Wherefore he saith, God resisteth the proud, but giveth grace unto the humble. Jas: 4:6

My offspring shall inherit the land.

Who is the man who reverently fears and worships the Lord? **Him shall He teach in the way that he should choose. He himself shall dwell at ease, and his offspring shall inherit the land.** Ps: 25:12-13 Amp. V

I shall be vindicated.

It is enough for the disciple that he be as his master, and the servant as his lord. If they have called the master of the house Beelzebub, how much more shall they call them of his household? **Fear them not therefore: for there is nothing covered, that shall not be revealed; and hid, that shall not be known.** Matt: 10:25-26

And shall not God avenge his own elect, which cry day and night unto him, though he bear long with them? **I tell you that he will avenge them speedily.** Nevertheless when the Son of man cometh, shall he find faith on the earth? Lk: 18:7-8

Who, when he was reviled, reviled not again; when he suffered, he threatened not; but committed himself to him that judgeth righteously: 1Pet: 2:23

Unto thee, O LORD, do I lift up my soul. 2: O my God, I trust in thee: let me not be ashamed, let not mine enemies triumph over me. 3: Yea, let none that wait on thee be ashamed: let them be ashamed which transgress without cause. Ps: 25:1-3

Encouragement:
